Specialist Designations are awarded upon completion of any AEI claims law program. Associate Designations are awarded upon completion of the Legal Principles program and any other AEI claims law program. For example, by completing the Liability program, a student earns the Casualty Claim Law Specialist designation. By completing the Legal Principles program and the Liability program, a student earns the Casualty Claim Law Associate designation. Other combinations produce other designations.

The ultimate designation a claims professional can earn is the SCLA (Senior Claim Law Associate). The SCLA is achieved by completing the Legal Principles program and three of the other five AEI programs: Liability, Property, Workers' Compensation, Automobile Claims and Coverage, and Claims Fraud Investigation and Defense.
